### **Survey Results**

Jason provided the 2011 Survey Monkey results to members prior to meeting (December 9 was the final day of the survey, with 60 participants). Members reviewed the results together, and overall results were very good! Members received some great feedback, and according to the results, the site is organized and functioning well!

Jason inquired about the possibility of updating the format of the home page. The survey results clearly indicated that our site and functionality doesn't need to change, and a drastic overhaul was unnecessary. A potential update to the layout of the home page however, is a possibility. Jason had created 2 "test" pages last year, and will send these examples to committee members.

### **Listserve/Announcements**

Jason provided a quick review of the intention of the Listserve/Announcements discussion forum to utilize as a request (call-out) for volunteer work or jobs. Jason reviewed the circumstance from GIS Day (and subsequent email sent by the individual) and the outcome (Jason sent an email asking for the committee's thoughts a few weeks ago). She has hesitantly posted thus far, and members agreed that Lee should not be responsible for posting and maintaining these postings. Members agreed that outside entities should pay for membership, and then post opportunities themselves.

GIS Day was a great success. Erin has been given Administrative privileges for this page, and has posted pictures. Members discussed the potential for this page to be the "GIS Day" resource for future celebrations (links for other state GIS Day's could be posted here, etc.). This idea is something to keep in mind for next year.

Stu inquired about the possibility of creating a webinar/video relating to the MLIA grant-writing process. Jason reviewed the email and his response to Stu for future expectations.
