Subject: MAGIP Task Force Recommendation for Membership Structure and Fees

Dear MAGIP Board of Directors,

The MAGIP Task Force for Membership Structure and Fees met virtually, September 9, 2022, October 28, 2022, and November 4, 2022, to discuss the proposed membership model(s). These models do not affect anything with the conference; its rates, and bonuses if you are a member. The Task Force reached consensus on the following proposed fee structure and membership model:

Individual Membership: \$50 Annually Student Membership: \$25 Annually Restructure Associate Membership as follows:

- Rename Associate Membership to "Organizational Membership,"
- Organizational Membership includes 5 members at the cost of \$250 Annually. Additional Members can be added at \$40 per person annually.

The Task Force requests the MAGIP Board take action to adopt the proposed model. We also recommend that the new model and rates go into effect no earlier than January 1, 2023, or upon renewal of memberships.
