Project Narrative *

The Gallatin Gateway Youth Group (GYG) is hosting a 3 day camp for 6th–8th graders in late July. A 3hr morning workshop will be given on GPS/GIS and geocaching. We are renting the GPS trunk from the MT Natural History center and will use them to locate a few geocaches in Gallatin Gateway and then conduct our own "treasure hunt" using the GPS units to navigate from point to point. We are expecting 10–15 kids to participate in the camp.
