New Board Business

- GIS Day, Nov 15, 2023
 - o Idea #1: Map Maker Kit for elementary schools in your neighborhood
 - Pros: great outreach opportunity
 - Cons: Extremely difficult to schedule external lesson plans with schools and must plan 6-10 months in advance. This doesn't leave enough time before GIS 2023, but could be implemented in 2024
 - Idea #2: State-wide coordinated effort for GIS meet-ups
 - Great social media opportunity
 - MSU had a GIS day posted on social media and our community engagement coordinator saw it and took a picture
 - Idea #3: Create a coordinated humanitarian effort with skilled GIS professionals/members
 - What: Create a coordinated effort to map assets that address climate change/natural disasters/sex trafficking on Open Street Maps
 - Ex. Mapping powerlines (fire potential, predatory birds) in a specific county or state
 - Coordinate participants to divide into two competitive teams
 - Post instructions on social media
 - If successful, this could transition into ongoing citizen science project

 - https://wiki.openstreetmap.org/wiki/Map_features
 - Where: Reserve space at your local public library with MAGIP paying for pizza. Virtual participation would also be an option.
 - Jeff will reach out to Billings library
