General Board Business:

- Approval of October 17, 2023 Minutes

- Treasurer's Report (Nate Wold)
 - o Savings: \$19,595
 - Checkings: \$2,306
 - Two new \$50 memberships
 - Paid \$500 for annual AGOL license
 - CD: \$25,242
 - Nate will cancel SurveyMonkey to avoid auto-renewal charge on November 23rd
 - o Upcoming annual Wild Apricot payment of \$2,592 due in November
 - Consider a two-year subscription in next year's budget to save \$144 annually
 - Treasurer received five requests for assistance: Helena, Bozeman, Billings, Bozeman, Missoula
 - Once reimbursement receipts are received, Nate will upload them to google drive with the meetup writeup, attendance list, and event pictures
- Member Development Committee (Mike Eidum)
 - \circ $\;$ The deadline to download surveys closes December 23 $^{\rm rd}$
 - Mike has started exporting surveys from 2022 and 2023
 - All exported surveys require reconfiguring for Survey123

 - Previous Meeting Topics:

 - Reinvigorated UM geography club
 - Billings: 20 attendees (MSU-B:4, Rocky College: 9, City of Billings: 4, Yellowstone County: 2, Homeschooler:1)
 - MSU-B volunteered to host the event next year

New Business

- Discuss providing comments on amendments to Montana Administrative Rule for the Montana Geospatial Information Act and the Montana Realtime Network
 - MAGIP supported the legislation in 2023 but feels the board is not educated enough to provide feedback on passive of proposed changes
 - Changes seem confusing and needs clarification
 - The board wants more information about charging for network and what that would cost
 - Jeff will respond to Erin Fashoway's request for comment by asking for more information
- Discuss 2024 Distinguished Service and GIS Professional Livability Awards process
 - Currently falls under the duties of Conference Planning committee/Conference Liaison
 - These duties could be part of the Scholarship and Grants Committee Chair position in the future
 - o Jeff will coordinate with Michelle to coordinate awards with the conference planning committee and Tessa will broach the subject at the upcoming meeting.
 - o Meghan will resend Michelle the <u>awards guidance</u> document.
