#### **New Business**

- Approval of <u>January 16, 2023 Meeting Minutes</u>
  - Motion to pass January board minutes:
    - Motion Proposed: Mike Powell
    - Second: Nate Wold
    - Passed Unanimously
- Discuss funds that are available to get students to the 2024 Big Sky GeoCon
  - Current Opportunities: First Come First Serve
    - Student conference fee waiver (scholarship)
      - Currently 10 student conference waivers available and can also include a travel stipend for travel >300 miles
      - Students are not required to volunteer because we utilize FullScope's services
      - MAGIP will reevaluate waiver distribution next year based on how many students apply this year
      - MAGIP will encourage instructors to spread the word about scholarships
    - Travel Stipend
      - \$150 stipend for students traveling to present at GeoCon
    - Request for Assistance: \$575 in the budget
      - Students can apply for assistance for flexible funding to use for conference transportation and registration
      - Students must be MAGIP members for this option which is a good way to encourage memberships
  - Consider adding a synopsis about available funding during application
  - Jenny sent out the scholarship Survey123 on the listserv last week after the conference planning committee discussed it
  - Mike E. will work with Alicia to distribute the survey and scholarship information on social media
- Location of June 2024 Quarterly Meeting

- $\circ$  Gail will discuss location options with Michelle and make an executive decision
- MAGIP discussed moving the fall strategic planning retreat to June in conjunction with the summer quarterly meeting
  - An earlier strategic retreat would be ideal for the budget and annual goals
