SIXTH ANNUAL MONTANA GIS CONFERENCE



The Montana GIS conference will allow Montana GIS users to share details of many of the complex and interesting projects undertaken in our state. With more than 1200 GIS users receiving the Montana GIS Users Newsletter, this forum will provide valuable and interesting information to all levels of GIS users. GIS users who are just starting will find significant information to promote their GIS use and understanding. Experienced users will find interesting subjects from across the state and northwest area.

The 1994 conference is being sponsored by the Montana GIS Users Group and coordinated by the following GIS users in Kalispell, Mt: Positive Systems, Flathead National Forest, MT Dept. of Fish, Wildlife and Parks, and Flathead County Surveyor's Office.

CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS:

PRE-CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS: Participants may select from 8 workshops that discuss topics of interest to GIS specialists and to novices. See attached information sheet about the workshops. Note that one workshop is on Thursday.

PLENARY SESSIONS: Several experts in GIS or related fields will address the conference on Wednesday the 6th. On Friday the 8th there will be a Montana GIS Users Group meeting followed by a meeting of the Montana GIS Interagency Technical Working Group with a panel discussion open to all attendees.

CONCURRENT SESSIONS: Attendees may select from three concurrent tracks, depending on their area of interest, to listen to papers on different aspects of GIS applications. They are: Natural Resources, Urban, and New Technology.

COMMERCIAL EXHIBITS: Major vendors of GIS/GPS hardware, software, and services will host exhibits during the conference.

GIS PUBLIC NIGHT: On Wednesday evening the 6th, the conference will be open to the general public at no charge. A short talk on GIS concepts will be presented. Poster presenters and vendors will be available to answer questions.

POSTER SESSION: Posters and exhibits will be on display throughout the conference and will be judged Wednesday evening at 6pm. Presenters should be available for the judging Wednesday and for questions and answers during GIS public night.

LUNCHES: With full conference registration, a light lunch will be provided on Wednesday the 6th and Thursday the 7th.

NOTE for all meals: Special diet requirements need to be coordinated at registration.

VIP DINNER: With full conference registration only, a ticket will be provided to the VIP dinner, which will begin at 7pm Thursday evening at Cavanaugh's. Other attendees and the general public will be able to buy a limited number of tickets at the conference registration desk for a fee of \$20.

MONTANA GIS USERS GROUP MEETING: The Montana GIS Users Group Board Meeting will be held Friday the 8th.

MONTANA GIS INTERAGENCY TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP: A panel discussion for all attendees will follow the business meeting on Friday the 8th.
